RING 2 RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP

First & Second From Classes 31-36

Rules

1. The committee of Manhood Riding Club will accept no responsibility for any injuries or damage caused to or by any person, horse or vehicle.
2. The judge's decision is final.
3. Any impolite or aggressive behaviour will result in that person/s being barred from the show with the loss of all their entry fees.
4. Any one mounted on the show ground must be wearing a correctly fitting riding hat.
5. All children under 16, showing ponies' in-hand must be wearing a correctly fitting riding hat.
6. No Children under 16, should be leading, showing or riding stallions of any breed or size.
7. No galloping other than in show ring.
8. Please pick up any litter.
9. No Dogs to be loose on show ground.
10. Classes will be split or amalgamated on the day if necessary.
11. Entry Fees will not be refunded if classes clash.
12. The secretary/show organiser/judge can refuse entries without giving a reason.
13. No horse/pony under the age of 4 years is to be ridden on the showground.
14. No uninsured drivers are allowed to drive/move vehicles on the show ground.
