- 10. No horse/pony under the age of 4 years is to be ridden on the showground.
- 11. No uninsured drivers are allowed to drive/move vehicles on the show ground.
- 12. No smoking in or around stables or school
- 13. It is a condition of entry to the show that you have public liability insurance for your horse/pony.
