TGCA TOYS In Hand and Ridden Classes -

No known breeding required to enter these classes

TGCA Breed classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed Finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association's (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show "TOYS". Classes are open to all traditional gypsy cobs. Part Bred classes, are open to all part bred traditional gypsy cobs and are qualifiers for the part bred finals at "TOYS". exhibit must have one parent that is pure bred traditional gypsy cob. The Stallions – All stallions (pure or part bred, four years and over) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class MUST be TGCA registered, have passed TGCA stallion evaluations and their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle. Stallions and colts over the age of two, MUST be shown in a stallion bridle with a metal bit and chain lead as per the current TGCA rulebook.

Current TGCA members must present their Membership card and Qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature.

Non-members MUST receive a qualification card from the judge and have 21 days to join the TGCA and register their horse to validate the qualification. MRC RULES/TGCA

1. The committee of Manhood Riding Club will accept no responsibility for any injuries or damage caused to or by any person, horse, or vehicle.
2. The judge's decision is final.
3. Any impolite or aggressive behaviour will result in that person/s being barred from the show with the loss of all their entry fees.
4. All children under 16, showing ponies in-hand must be wearing a correctly fitting riding hat.
5. No Children under 16, should be leading, showing or riding stallions of any breed or size.
6. Please pick up any litter.
7. **No Dogs to be loose on show ground & no dogs allowed in stable yard or school**
8. Classes will be split or amalgamated on the day if necessary.
9. The secretary/show organiser/judge can refuse entries without giving a reason.
10. No horse/pony under the age of 4 years is to be ridden on the showground.
11. No uninsured drivers are allowed to drive/move vehicles on the show ground.
12. No smoking in or around stables or school
13. **It is a condition of entry to the show that you have public liability insurance for your horse/pony.**

Show Entry Conditions

Entries are deemed as in acceptance of ALL relevant TGCA rules including the showing rules set out in the current members handbook (please refer to TGCA website) as well as those on this schedule

- The TGCA reserves the right to refuse an entry without giving a reason.
- The TGCA reserves the right to alter or cancel any class it sees fit without giving a reason
- Classes may be split into sections if entries warrant.
- Hats must always be worn and must be up to current safety standards in accordance with affiliated rules when riding. The decision of the judges and/or the TGCA is final.
- Members and competitors must comply with all the showground rules.
- Dogs must be kept on leads at all times. Owners must pick up after their dogs, anyone found not doing so will be fined £10 and may be asked to leave the showground.
- Mucking out onto the showground is forbidden. Please ensure you pick up droppings and loose hay before you depart and leave the parking area clean and tidy.
- Any person participating in any way or who conducts themselves in a manner that might bring the Association into disrepute will be asked to leave the showground and may be subject to disciplinary action.
- Neither the organisers, Landowners, Committee or Agents of the TGCA accept liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land or any person or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever
